****The Standard DV plate is the only plate type that says "Disabled Veteran" on the plate. These plates cannot be used to park in handicapped parking spaces in Wyoming. To legally park in handicap parking, a separate handicap parking placard must be obtained. This is the only DV plate type that can be used on a MPV.**

If you are applying for a Gold Star Plate as your free DV plate, **PROCEED TO STEPS 5,8, & 9**

If you are applying for a Service-Connected Plate as your free DV plate, **PROCEED TO STEPS 6, 8 & 9**

If you are applying for a Veteran Plate as your free DV plate, **PROCEED TO STEPS 7, 8 & 9**

If you are applying for a free Standard DV Plate, **PROCEED TO STEPS 8 & 9**

	The following items must be mailed with your application: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>National Guard (Air or Army):</u> Documentation that applicant is currently serving in an active or retired status of the Wyoming Army or Air National Guard. • <u>Pearl Harbor Survivor:</u> Documentation that applicant was a member of the United States Armed Forces on December 7, 1941, on station during the hours of 7:55 a.m. to 9:45 a.m., December 7, 1941, Hawaii time at Pearl Harbor, the island of Oahu, or offshore at a distance not to exceed three (3) miles and received an honorable discharge from the United States Armed Forces. • <u>Purple Heart Recipient:</u> Documentation that applicant is an official recipient of the United States Military Purple Heart Award. • <u>Prisoner of War:</u> Documentation that while serving in the United States Armed Forces, applicant was incarcerated by an enemy of the U.S. during a period of conflict with the United States. STEP #7	IF YOU ARE APPLYING FOR A VETERAN PLATE – PLEASE READ THE FOLLOWING	
	The following items must be mailed with your application: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • A copy of your DD 214 discharge certificate or separation papers. Do not submit an original. Upon verification of service, the copy will be destroyed. PROCEED TO STEPS 8 & 9	
STEP #8	FINALIZE AND SUBMIT YOUR APPLICATION	
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Attach proof of 50 percent or more service connected disability compensation from the VA. • If you have chosen a Gold Star, Service-Connected, or Veteran plate, attach the required documents for your plate type (listed in steps 5, 6, or 7). • If you have requested an embossed plate, attach a \$50.00 fee payable to WYDOT. • Read, sign, and date the affidavit in Step 9. • Take/mail your application to the County Treasurer’s office in your county of registration.
