WY DECP Program Update and Coordinator Introduction

Fentanyl: Looking at the Layers of a Deadly Epidemic

This class will discuss what Fentanyl is and how it enters the United States. We will discuss the different forms of Fentanyl and how it is associated in other synthetic trends. This presentation will cover the different ways Fentanyl is ingested into the human body along with the signs and symptoms. Furthermore, we will go into the observations of overdose and withdrawal. Finally, the presentation will cover Narcan, social media and close with a case study.

Joint Ventures: Navigating the Hazy Landscape of Cannabis

This session covers street-level trends and influences that have arisen with the arrival of marijuana legalization. It will show examples from different states that have legalized marijuana, including: new products, trends, signs of impairment and marijuana related times. It will also provide information on CBD, Delta 8 and 10 and what are the differences between these products and marijuana and how do we know what is being sold in "head-shops" is not marijuana.

Working Lunch - Special Presentations and Impaired Driving in a Rural Environment Panel

This panel discussion and Q&A session will bring together a diverse group of professionals to provide insight into the unique challenges their profession experiences as a result of a DUI arrest and strategies they deploy to successfully remove impaired drivers from Wyoming roadways.

A Mile High & Selling 'Shrooms – Preparing for the Sale of Hallucinogens

In Colorado, voters approved Proposition 122, which decriminalized certain psychedelic plants and fungi for personal use by individuals aged 21 and older and established the Regulated Natural Medicine Access Program for licensed healing centers to provide natural medicine services. Since its approval, Colorado has been dealing with the consequences of this measure, including the establishment of a regulated therapeutic system and the decriminalization of specific psychedelics. Drawing from the experience of marijuana legalization in the state, prosecutors and LEOs anticipate potential unintended consequences, such as a rise in illegal markets, impaired driving, and community impacts. Learn about Proposition 122, legislative responses, immediate effects, and the potential outcomes of Colorado's latest drug legalization encounters, offering insights for other states considering similar measure
