WYDOT's wyoroad.info website offers latest travel information

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the most severe travel conditions.

Additionally, motorists can access forecasted travel weather impacts, sign up for the 511 Notify text and email alerting system and learn more about the Wyoming 511 app for smartphones.

The Wyoming 511 app provides pre-trip map-based information and a hands-free/eyes-free function that speaks road conditions based on a traveler's location, making it possible to receive road condition updates without looking at a phone.

WYDOT officials are also working on revamping the Authorized Travel Program to provide more options for travelers. Once the program is finalized, WYDOT will put a new link to the program on the traveler information website.

Motorists will then apply for the travel options they need. WYDOT officials anticipate the new program will launch in mid-October.

Winter is knocking on our door. Be prepared – know before you go with wyoroad.info

When winter weather strikes, motorists can visit the Wyoming Department of Transportation's traveler information website at <https://wyoroad.info> for the latest road and travel information.

WYDOT's website provides travelers the latest information on road conditions and travel restrictions.

"Motorists who may need to travel during winter conditions can be better prepared by visiting our traveler information website," said Vince Garcia, WYDOT's GIS/ITS program manager. "We have all the latest information

posted on our site. We also have a map feature that motorists can access where they can activate different layers to get the information they need."

The traveler information map at <https://map.wyoroad.info> allows users to access web cameras, weather stations, construction zone information, size and weight restrictions, variable speed limit signs, electronic roadside signs, road conditions, travel impacts and other information to help make informed travel decisions.

Web cameras are available to give motorists a visual idea of road conditions and the travel impacts layer pro-

vides information on current conditions on a section of road. For example, a green line indicates weather conditions will have minimal impact on travel while the color red indicates the road is closed.

The reason for the road closure and an estimated opening time, when available, are provided. Information is also organized with web pages dedicated to specific routes and regions, making it easier to view multiple web cameras, weather stations, and details about road conditions at once. There is also a closures and advisories link that lists only

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Northwest Wyoming - A

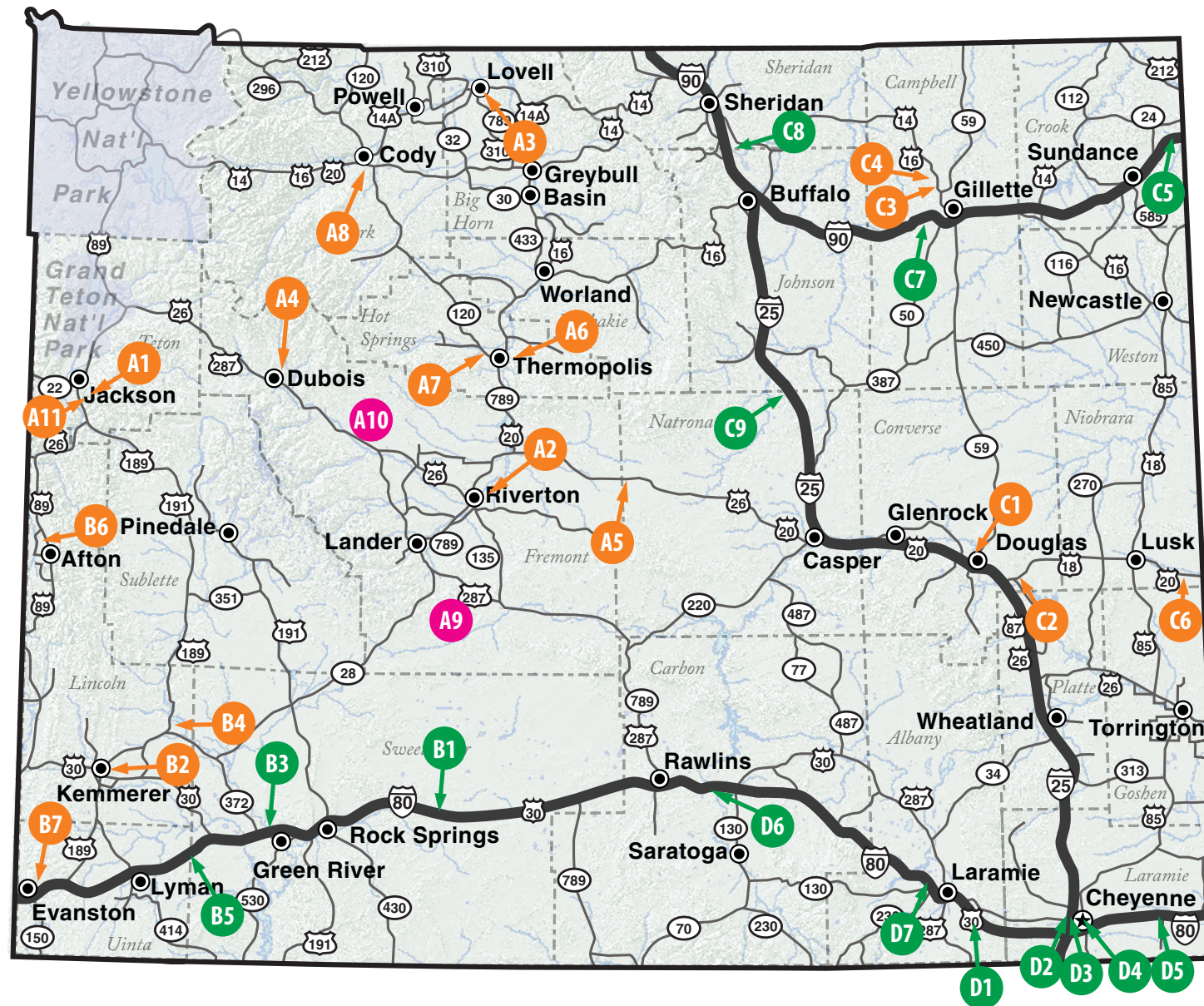
- A1** US 26/89/189/191 south of Jackson: Road widening, two bridge replacements, wildlife mitigation, turnouts, addition of pedestrian/bike pathways, MM 145-149. Fall completion.
- A2** US 26/West Main Street in Riverton, ADA work, intersection reconstruction, installation of new traffic signal. November completion.
- A3** US 310, between Lovell and Cowley: Widening and realignment of additional lanes mostly complete with some repairs in 2020 to approach slab to bridge over the railroad.
- A4** US 26/287 pavement overlay from Dubois city limits MM 56.4 to MM 67.25. June 2021 completion.
- A5** US 20/26. Construction of seven sets of passing lanes between Moneta and Waltman. October completion.
- A6** US 20/WYO 789 ADA, pavement rehab on 2.6 miles in Thermopolis. June 2021 completion.
- A7** WYO 120 road reconstruction, pavement rehab on 6.8 miles of highway to MM 74. Chip seal. June 2021 completion.
- A8** US 14/16/20 concrete rehab in Cody. September 2021 completion.
- A9** District fencing. Various locations. WYO 28, US 287. October 2021 completion.
- A10** District guardrail replacement. US 26, US 287, WYO 135, WYO 789 and US 20. October completion.
- A11** US 26/89/189/191 Jackson South. Milling, paving, wearing course work on 3.10 miles beginning at MM 148.70.

Southwest Wyoming - B

- B1** I-80 near Point of Rocks. Bridge work, mill, overlay. Head-to-head traffic. EB closed MM 120-130. 16-ft. width restriction. October completion.
- B2** Kemmerer East: Grading, paving, bridge rehab on 8.90 miles on US 30 at MM 57.99 between Kemmerer and Opal. June 2021 completion.
- B3** La Barge Interchange West: Grading, milling, paving, concrete pavement, bridge rehabs on 5.30 miles of WB I-80 at MM 77.45 between Granger Jct. and Green River. October completion.
- B4** US 189 Muddy Creek: Grading, milling, paving, chip seal on 8.20 miles of US 189 at MM 10.23 between Lazear Jct. and Kemmerer. October completion.
- B5** I-80 east of Lyman. Grading, milling, resurfacing and bridge rehab between MM 49-57. October 2021 completion.
- B6** WYO 238 Auburn to Afton: MM 0-12. Grading, draining, placing crushed base and pavement surfacing, reclamation, chip seal, bridge replacements on 12.10 miles. Fall completion.
- B7** Evanston Streets: Grading, paving, reclamation, wearing course, sidewalk, curb/gutter, electrical work on 0.50 miles on WYO 89 (Harrison Street) at MM 4.32 in Evanston. November completion.

- I** **Interstate highway work zones:** Generally, there are no delays or detours. Travel may be narrowed to one lane (on pavement) each way and involve a reduced speed limit.
- P** **Two-lane road projects:** Motorists may be required to stop and wait to follow pilot cars. Usually, any delays are limited to 20 minutes or less and travel is on pavement.
- R** **Two-lane road projects:** At times, motorists may have to drive on gravel or another temporary surface, typically for two miles or less. Delays are limited, there are no detours unless specifically noted but there may be a pilot car.
- D** **District-wide projects:** Various locations, may involve reduced speeds.
- ⊘** **Not every project is listed**
Due to the unpredictable nature of the construction process, not all projects are active all the time. In addition, some short-term projects and smaller projects which disrupt traffic to a lesser degree are not listed. Completion dates are approximate.
Commercial vehicle operators: In work zones, size and weight restrictions may apply. Ask for details at any Wyoming port of entry or call (307) 777-4376. Current restrictions are also available on the Internet at www.wyoroad.info/highway/restrictions.html.

Central & Northeast Wyoming - C

- C1** Work on WYO 59/I-25 junction to MM 8.75. October 2021 completion.
- C2** US 18/20 near Orin Junction: Grading, milling plant mix, new pavement, bridge rehab between MM 0.0-6.2. Single-lane traffic at MM 2.98 with traffic signals. June 2021 completion.
- C3** US 14/16 MM 96 Rawhide Creek Bridge replacement.
- C4** US 14/16 MM 88 Wildcat Creek Bridge replacement.
- C5** I-90 MM 205 Buelah exit. Both directions. Overpass bridge deck repair. 14-foot width restriction, single lane, reduced speeds. October completion.
- C6** US 20 east of Lusk to Van Tassell, west section. Reconstruction with full-depth reclamation, overlay between MMs 41.71-54.80. 2021 completion.
- C7** I-90 MM 76 bridge deck repair, 14-ft width restrictions, single lane, reduced speeds. October completion.
- C8** I-90: Roadwork EB/WB lanes between Buffalo and Sheridan between MMs 45-33. Reduced speeds at bridge decks, lane closures, flaggers, heavy truck traffic.
- C9** I-25 NB lanes between MMs 244-253. Mill, overlay, structure rehabilitation.

Southeast Wyoming - D

- D1** I-80 Telephone Canyon/Summit rest area: bridge rehab, paving. Lane closures. Fall completion.
- D2** I-25 bridge rehab near Missile Drive. Lane closures. Late-October completion.
- D3** I-25 slab repairs MM 11-16. Median and shoulder work. October completion.
- D4** I-180 in Cheyenne (Central and Warren Ave. bridges) bridge rehabilitation. Fall completion.
- D5** I-80 between Pine Bluffs and Cheyenne. Bridge replacement MMs 372-382. October 2021 completion.
- D6** Ft Steele Rest Area (I-80 MM 230). Closed for Winter Freight Project construction.
- D7** I-80 sign upgrade project, MM 281-337, some lane closures likely, late-fall completion.
