

**PUBLIC NOTICE OF INTENT TO ADOPT

The Wyoming Department of Transportation (WYDOT) hereby gives public notice of intent, in accordance with W.S. 16-3-103, to revise the following rules and regulations:

Motor Carrier Section, Chapter 1, *Motor Carriers*

**Chapter 1, *Motor Carriers***, is a revised rule and regulation of the Wyoming Department of Transportation.

This rule revision primarily updates Section 6 provisions related to Towing and Recovery Vehicles. The revisions to both the rule and the accompanying procedures in Appendix B were undertaken after the public expressed concerns with towing practices in Wyoming. In addition, equipment requirements were revised to conform to modern industry standards.

This rule also revises definitions in Section 2. Communications procedures in Section 4 have also been updated with current electronic business practices. The letter of authority changes throughout the rule align with modernized procedures concerning the types of authority issued to carriers. Other changes have been made to conform these rules to the Secretary of State's required format and improve readability.
