The Wyoming Department of Transportation (WYDOT) hereby gives public notice of intent, in accordance with W.S. 16-3-103, to promulgate the following rules and regulations:

Motor Vehicles and Licensing Section, Chapter 12, *Wildlife Conservation License Plates*

Chapter 12, *Wildlife Conservation License Plates*, is a new rule and regulation of the Wyoming Department of Transportation.

This is a new rule that specifies WYDOT's program and account procedures for wildlife conservation license plates, including eligible project types and activities that may be funded from the account.
