An MPV must have at least 4 wheels in contact with the ground, have an unladen weight between 300 and 3,000 lbs, have a permanent seat or saddle at least 24 inches from the ground, and an identifying number assigned by the manufacturer pursuant to WS 31-1-101(a)(xv)(M). An ORV-MC is any motorcycle not required by law to be licensed that has an unladen weight of 600 lbs or less, is designed to be ridden off road with the operator astride upon a seat or saddle and travels on 2 tires. MPV's and ORV-MC's are not required to have a U.S Federal Safety Label in order to be titled and registered in Wyoming, and registration is only required if operated on public roadways.

«NOTICE TO OPERATOR - EQUIPMENT REQUIRED FOR OPERATION »

Multipurpose vehicles and Off-Road Recreational Vehicle-Motorcycle operated on streets, roads, or highways in the State of Wyoming are required to be equipped with specific equipment pursuant to Title 31, Chapter 5, of Wyoming Statutes. All equipment shall be operational and meet statutory requirements before registration is issued. Operation on Interstate Roadways is prohibited.

- Multipurpose vehicles designed for operation at speeds less than twenty-five (25) miles per hour SHALL be equipped with a \checkmark slow moving vehicle emblem as described in W. S. 31-5-921 (h).
- A valid drivers' license and insurance are required to operate MPV's and ORV-MC's on streets, roads, or highways.
