




Funding Fiscal Year 2018 - \$581,664,474



Number of Projects Let & Cost per Fiscal Year











- The new Snowy Range Road Bridge is scheduled to open July 16


-The bridge opening will be preceded by a ribbon-cutting ceremony










Laramie/3rd Street (Curtis-Boswell) Mill, Overlay, ADA, Traffic Signals: \$4.8 million

WYDOT Updates

I-80 speed limit increase

- WYDOT plans to raise the speed limit on I-80 to
 80 mph between Creston Jct. (Exit 187) and
 Rawlins/Johnson Road (Exit 209)
- I-80 east of Rawlins will remain at 75 mph



WYDOT Updates "Move over" law

Drivers will need to move over or slow down for WYDOT
 & construction, utility, and local government vehicles
 parked on the side of the road

- The law is effective July 1.
- -This bill helps protect our workers!

WYDOT Updates Sorting Traffic – I-25 & I-80

For some wind events, WHP & WYDOT have sorted light
 & high-profile vehicles from other traffic

-This is meant to prevent blowovers due to drivers ignoring closure warnings

-This process has been used on I-25 in conjunction with the Colorado DOT







- WYDOT is beginning the planning phase for two major projects:

-The reconstruction of the I-80/I-25 interchange in Cheyenne, and

-Widening I-80 to three lanes in each direction





- A new wildlife-themed license plate will be available by early 2019

-Fees from the plate will go to the Wildlife Conservation Account in the State Highway Fund

-The plate will cost an initial \$150 and then \$50 to renew

-The final design is in development
