Employee Safety Program completed the jib crane installation at 52 locations to satisfy a worker's compensation agreement.

CRASH TEAM 3D SCANNERS

WYDOT purchased two 3D scanners from Collision Forensic Solutions, LLC, for WHP crash teams.



Bridge Program performed 1,515 routine bridge inspections and 10 tunnel inspections, including 42 non-redundant steel tension member inspections, 12 overhead sign structure inspections, 116 high mast light tower inspections, 7 DR bridge inspections, and 47 underwater inspections.

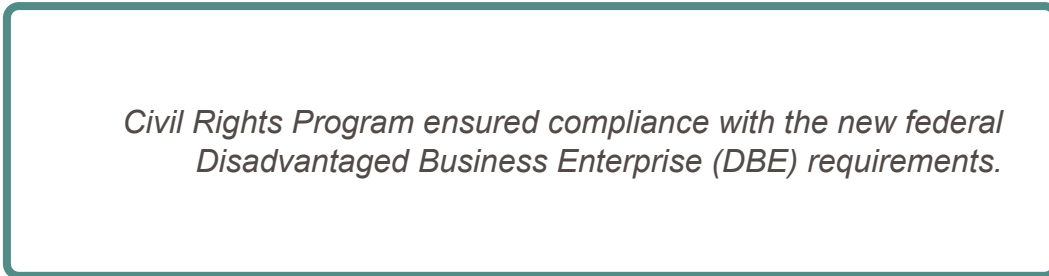

Standards Unit successfully completed crash testing to the Manual for Assessing Safety Hardware (MASH) for the Wyoming road closure gate after an initial failing test occurred, which required the team to redesign the gate arm bracket.

2025 VEHICLE DEALER INVESTIGATION

Background:

The Compliance & Investigation Program investigated and assisted with multiple title fraud cases upon referral from counties and counterparts in other states.

Process:

Investigators revoked fraudulently obtained Wyoming titles and registrations and communicated with effected jurisdictions and victims.

Result:

Compliance worked with the Public Affairs Office to release public service announcements warning the public to be aware of fraud schemes.
