Her suggestion is to add some notation on the license for "permanent non-residents" (because they do get the gold star). She doesn't know if there is any law against doing this, there could be.

Her request is not a suggestion that WYDOT is doing anything wrong, not by any means. But with the current rhetoric of voter fraud, this would be helpful for Clerks and Election Judges to identify "permanent non-residents" who attempt to register and vote on Election Day.
