




Capital Improvement Projects – 1 year plan



- U.S. 85: Overlay between mileposts 66 72
- Guardrail Upgrade various Goshen/Platte county locations



2025

- U.S. 26: (Guernsey to Ft. Laramie) Overlay and chip seal between mileposts 20 – 28.17
- WYO 157: Bridge rehabilitation at milepost 7.03 (North Platte River)

2026

WYO 151: Bridge Rehabilitation at milepost 3.89 (Horse Creek)



2027

- WYO 158 (Table Mountain Road): Chip seal between Huntley and the Nebraska state line (mileposts 0.0 – 8.02)
- WYO 161: Yoder to Huntley Full depth pavement reclamation between mileposts 0 – 7

2028

 WYO 154: Bridge rehabilitation at milepost 22 (bridge over Ft. Laramie Canal).

Transit Projects

The Federal Transit Administration (FTA) and the Wyoming Legislature annually apportion funds to WYDOT for public transit.

WYDOT funds public transportation in all 23 counties

- Public Transit is primarily provided by senior centers within the state
- Local match is between 15% 50 % depending on the funding type
- Applications are available from March 1 April 15th annually

Funds are available:

- For Operating, Administration and Preventive Maintenance of public transit operations
- To replace, rehabilitate and purchase buses and related equipment and to construct bus-related facilities
- Multimodal transportation planning
- Inter-city bus transportation


