

D District-wide projects: Various locations, may involve reduced speeds.



- A1 US 16/20/WYO 789: Basin-Grevbull drainage improvements/milling/paving project. Stormwater drainage improvements, pavement milling, asphalt pavement overlay, chip seal on 5.80 miles starting at MM 197.70 between Greybull and Basin. Delays expected.
- A2 US 26/287: Moran Junction-Dubois, Buffalo Fork Section. Asphalt milling, overlay, chip seal, bridge rehab over Buffalo Fork of the Snake River. MM 2.2-7.53. Portable traffic signal. Delays expected.
- A3 WYO 433: Worland-Manderson. Bridge replacements, reconstruction of roadway north of Worland. Demolition/reconstruction of three bridges. grading, asphalt pavement surfacing, fencing, chip sealing. MM 4.14-5.50. Delays expected.

- B3 Rock Springs/I-80 Interchange Rd.: Replace/reconstruct interchange: 0.81 miles.
- B4 Contract patch in various locations: Lincoln, Uinta, Sweetwater Counties, Bituminous surfacing, milling, traffic control and other work.



- **C1** *I-25:* Five bridge replacements. Surfacing and other work between MM 189-190. Affects both NB and SB lanes.
- **C2** WYO 95: Surfacing and bridge rehabilitation between MM 1.69-7.65.
- (3 WYO 220: Casper Streets - Drainage, surfacing, traffic control and other work on .30 miles of Poplar Street beginning at MM 115.80.
 - WYO 59: Mill and overlay: structure rehabilitation and other work on 7.70 miles beginning at MM 19.30 north of Douglas in the Lightning Creek area.
- **(C5)** *I-25:* District 2 Bridge Rehabilitation Various locations and travel directions on I-25 including at MMs 33, 45, 46 (SBL) and at Orin Junction.



WYO 220/WYO 258: Intersection rehabilitation: mill, pavement inlay, curb and gutter, sidewalk and ADA upgrades.

Southeast Wyoming - D

- D1 US 30/East Lincolnway: MM 365.74-368.36, project includes new box culvert for Chevenne Greenway Underpass, other work will include milling and paving, shoulder work, signal installation at Whitney, a median island installed from Pershing to Whitney, and extending the 5-lane section.
- Curtis St. in Laramie: From 3rd St. to McCue St., work will include minor bridge repairs to the UPRR Bridge and the Laramie River Bridge, as well as a mill and overlay.
- I-80: MM 258.9-267.19 (EB only) and Wagonhound Rest Area, work includes mill & overlay, Rest Area resurfacing.
- D4 District 1 Bridge rehab: First bridge is at MM 302.91 in the EB lanes on I-80. Then move to the WB structure at MM 300.44. Other locations: I-80 EB structure at 245.94 and WYO 76 at MM 221.68, the UPRR overpass by the East Sinclair interchange. Work includes four structure rehabilitations.
- D5 College Drive (1-25 to US 85): The project will take place on WYO 212/College Dr. between the I-25 interchange and US 85/S. Greeley Highway (MM 0.14-2.71). Work includes new asphalt surfacing, ADA upgrades, concrete repairs to some approaches near the I-25 interchange. Detours provided to maintain access to businesses and side roads. There will be a 16-foot width restriction in place.
 - WYO 72. Elk Mountain: WYO 72 from I-80 to

the town of Elk Mountain. MM 12.37-15.98. Mill. overlay, structure and drainage work.



D8 US 30: in Pine Bluffs from Parson Street to NE state line (401-403). Work includes replacing a box culvert, mill and overlay, and new railroad crossing at Butler Ave.
